Teams will prepare an executive summary over winter break to submit on Friday, January 17, 2025. From there, judges will select the teams that will compete in the final round on Friday, February 7, 2025 in Fulton Hall.

Who can participate? Students must be in the class of 2026, 2027, or 2028 at Boston College. Students will compete as a team of two where at least one member of the team must be in the Carroll School of Management.
